- After cleaning or backwashing, let the filtration system run for at least 5-10 minutes before reconnecting the cleaner.

 can take hold of your body, hair, or clothing. The suction from the hose or cleaner, or just the hose or
 cleaner alone, can trap a swimmer underwater. NEVER ALLOW ANYONE TO ENTER THE POOL
 when the cleaner is in use.
- **DO NOT** allow anyone, especially children, to use or play with or around the cleaner or hose. Educate the pool users about the dangers of the hose, cleaner, and suction ports.
- STOP PUMP Cleaner must be completely disabled by turning off the pool's pump and suction before cleaning or maintaining the cleaner. Moving parts and suction can injure fingers or body.
- **STOP PUMP** before swimming. The moving pool cleaner, hose, and suction ports can injure or entrap swimmers. **STOP PUMP**, detach hose, and move the cleaner and hose to an unused corner of the pool. If the hose may interfere with the swimmers, remove it from the pool.
- Carefully follow all instructions contained in this manual. Failure to do so may inhibit the cleaner's operation or damage your pool. The manufacturer disclaims any liability for repairs or replacement to any structures or components in the customer's pool. This cleaner was not designed to be the first clean after pool construction or at the beginning of the season. Check your vinyl pool for wear or tear, or for roots, branches, rocks, or other obstructions under the liner. Gunite, plaster, and tile pools must be free of deterioration, cracked or loose tiles, or other conditions that could damage the cleaner. All pools must be cleaned of algae and debris prior to the cleaner's first use.



It is powered by jets for vacuum and scrubs the pool bottom, walls and steps. It also comes with a chamber filter bag for hold debris before it reaching pump basket or filter.




INSTALLATION / OPERATION

QUICK INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION

1. First install the Universal Wall Fitting (93270-37) on the pool's outlet fitting.




- 2. Measure the hose and check if the length of the hose is equal to the greatest depth of the pool. Screw the Universal Wall Fitting into the Quick Disconnect and the another end of the hose must be over 30cm of the farthest point of the pool. If the hose is too long, screw off each section from the swivel connector. Each section of sweep hose is 2.4m. If the hose is too short, purchase another feed hose section, one swivel connector and 2 hose nuts.
- 3. Assemble the Cleaner: Use the nut to attach the feed hose to the feed pipe and screw the nut upward. The cleaner and feed hose will be fixed together tightly. Then install the All Purpose Bag and Head Float. At the top of the bag is a quick connector, connect it on the feed hose.



- 4. Check the pressure of the pump outlet is between 3kgs-3.5kgs, or turn the pump on and hold the cleaner below the water level and count wheel revolutions for one minute. The optimum speed should be between 28-35RPM
- 5. The Thrust Jet (93270-28) us at the back side of the cleaner. Factory position is upward about 10 degrees. The thrust jet could adjust the direction of the cleaner. The adjustable nut at the top of the outlet hose. The water flow of the sweep hose could be adjusted by this nut to control the switch range and frequency of the sweep hose.

OPERATION / MAINTENANCE

When installing correctly, start up the pump, then the "Clean" will start to clean the pool. The cleaner will collect all debris into the All Purpose Bag and clean the pool floor and side walls. The cleaner will climb best in pools without sharp angles and curves in the transition from the pool floor to the pool wall. Approximately every three minutes the cleaner will go into back-up mode.



- **1.** Before or after using the cleaner, check the filter bag if there is debris, clean it out.
- **2.** After using the cleaner, clean the filter bag at least once. Do this by removing the bag from the cleaner, open the bag closure at one side and empty the bag, backwash it clean and close the bag back up.
- **3.** Never store the cleaner in direct sunlight. If you don't use the cleaner for an extended period, drain out all water and store it in a clean, dry area out of the reach of children.
