


# A-FRAME ABOVE GROUND POOL LADDER

### **SAFETY WARNINGS**






- · Locate the ladder on a solid, flat surface.
- One person should be permitted on the ladder at a time.
- The Ladder MUST be installed and used per manufacturers instructions only.
- DANGER: No Jumping or Diving from ladder.
- · Do not let children play on or near the ladder
- In order to avoid injury during the installation and handling of heavy objects, it is recommended to have two people carry the ladder at a time.
- To prevent entrapment or drowning DO NOT swim through, behind or around ladder.
- DO NOT install the ladder at the suction point.
- Exceeding the maximum weight restriction of 250lbs may cause the ladder to fail.
- · When ladder is not in use be sure lock up outer treads.

### **SAVE THESE WARNINGS.**


- 1. Remove the A-Frame ladder and its accessories from the box and check whether all the accessories are complete.
- 2. First place the bottom tread on a flat surface with the grooved side facing up; then snap the two holders into the groove. Note: The two holders need to be snapped into the groove in the same direction.




3. Install four treads to the holder, see the picture as below. Affix the top tread to the holder by #10x1-1/4 screws.



4. Affix the left and right fixing strips with bolt & gasket ( M6), and nut M6\*85, do not over tighten (the accessories are in screw kit 5862050002 )




5. Use the 10x1-1/4 screws to affix the other three treads. Then put aside for later.




Tighten with two screws for both sides


6. Put another bottom tread on a flat surface with the grooved side facing up. Then snap the two holders into the groove. Note: The two holders need to be snapped into the groove in the same direction.




7. ffix the treads to the holders with screws with #10x1-1/4.



8. Place the Lower Base on a level surface. Snap the front barrier into the groove on the lower base facing round edge. Snap the back barrier into the groove on the lower base facing the straight side.




9. Slide the upper brace over the front barrier as shown. Slide the upper brace through the groove in the Back Barrier and push down lightly to secure.




10. Affix the lower base of the entrapment barrier into bottom step of the Inside portion of the Ladder with 2 pieces  $10 \times 1-1/4$  screws.


Affix the barrier onto these two positions.




11. Affix the remaining two treads with  $10 \times 1-1/4$  screws to the holder in the groove positions



12. The ladder is designed to fit multiple pool heights. If your pool height is 52", locate the first line on the handrail of the ladder. Using a hacksaw, cut the handrail evenly through both sides.




If the pool height is 48", locate the second line on the handrail. Using a hacksaw, cut the handrail evenly through both sides. Locate the line on the holder and cut the redundancies evenly through both sides.




If your pool height is 54" there is no need to cut it.

13. Using a funnel, fill both holders with sand. Use approximately 20 Lbs. of sand in each holder. The barrier in step 11 have the front and back barrier.






14. Assemble the handrails to the platform. Center the cover cap opening on the side of the handrail when the platform was just attached. Using a rubber mallet/hammer, tap on the cap until the cap is flush with the handrail.




15. Attach handrails by pushing them down over the holders.

#### 16. Secure all handrails to the legs with #10 1-1/4# screws



Place the ladder inside the pool where you w to enter and exit. The entrapment barrier should be inside of the pool. Once the ladder is placed in the pool, tip the ladder forwards and backwards and side to side to release any air that may be trapped inside.



The swing up outer tread is at the outside of pool

Place weighted sandbags and/or sand-filled containers on the base of the steps to secure it in place. Sold separately.






The A-Frame ladder must be fixed on the edge of the pool. First, align the two holes on the surface of the deck platform with the edge of the pool, mark the hole positions at the edge of the pool with a fine marker pen, then drill through the edge of the swimming pool with a 5 / 16 "drill bit, and finally use bolts, nuts and washers to fix the ladder on the edge of the swimming pool.


If your pool height is 48", use the 2.5 bolt 5862050000 screw kit. If your pool height is 52", use the 5 bolt 58620500001 screw kit.

If your pool height is 54", use the 5 bolt 5862050001 screw kit.



#### **Routine Maintenance**

When the swimming pool is not in use, it is recommended to flip the outer ladder upwards, then push it down and fix it.




- 1. In cold weather and/or wintertime, remove the ladder and store it in a clean, dry place.
- 2. When removing the ladder, it is recommended to wash the ladder with soapy water to remove and debris.
