- 1. Bell Rocker
- 2. Bell Housing
- 3. Rocker Arm
- 4. Dinger
- 5. Cradle
- 6. Dinger Holder
- 7. Nut
- 8. Nuts and Bolt for Rocker Arm

1. Attach the #3 Rocker Arm to the #1 Bell Rocker, using #7 and #8 Nut and Bolt.









2. Next, attach the **#5 Cradle** to the **#1 Bell Rocker** by sliding it into the openings on the **Cradle**.

3. Next, attach the #1 Bell Rocker to the #2 Bell Housing by screwing in the #4 Dinger Eye Hook.









4. Attach the **#4 Dinger** to the **#6 Dinger Holder.** 



Final assembly should look like this.
