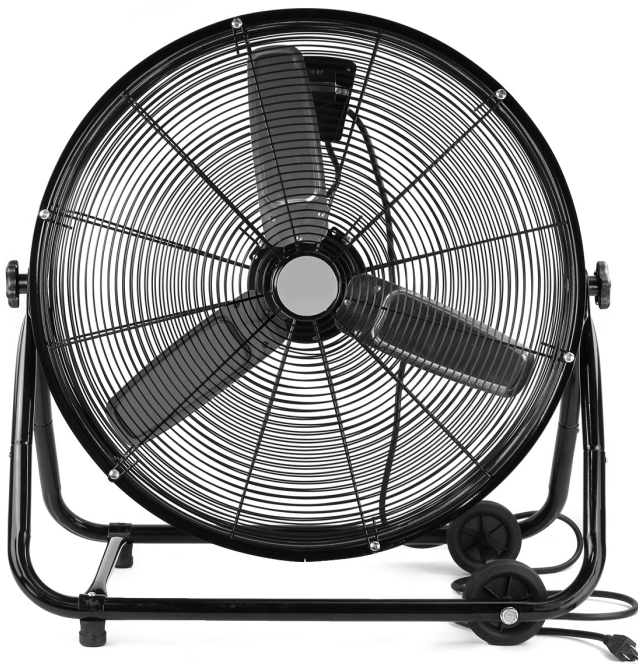

- DO NOT unplug the fan by pulling the cable cord. Unplug by holding the plug and pulling.
- DO NOT use the fan when there is damage to the cable cord or plug. If the supply cord is damaged, it has to be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons.
- DO NOT use the fan with an extension cord.
- DO NOT use the fan close to fires or flammable material.
- DO NOT insert your hand or other objects into the grille or the movable parts.
- To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not use this fan with any solid-state speed control device.
- DO NOT use this fan outdoors, this fan is designed for indoor use only.
- Unplug the fan from the socket and clean it with a soft cloth.
- DO NOT immerse the fan in liquid.
- Fit the guard onto the fan before starting up the fan.
- This fan is not intended for use by people (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the fan by a person responsible for their safety. Supervise children to ensure they do not play with the fan.

OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE

ADJUSTING AIRFLOW UPWARDS AND DOWNWARDS: Tilt the fan head to the desired angle. This high velocity fan can be used alone or in conjunction with air conditioners. Rotating the fan upwards serves to pull air from the floor and circulate it throughout the room.

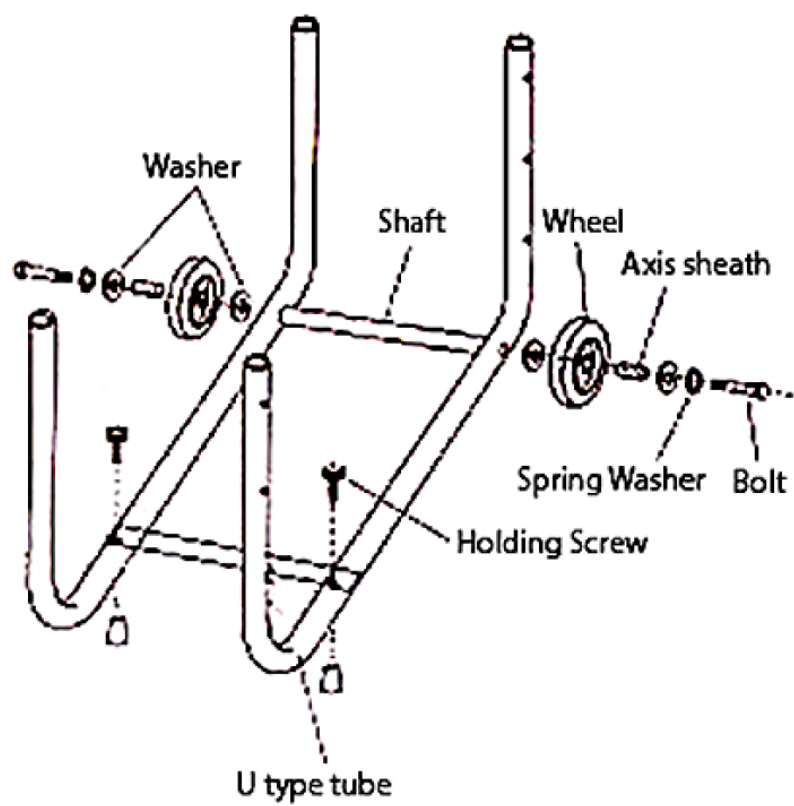
SPEED CONTROL: Rotate the switch from LOW to HIGH speeds for respective air velocity. It is normal for the motor to feel warm to the touch after continuous operation. this fan features a thermostat that will automatically shut off when the fan overheats. If this happens, immediately unplug the fan and let it cool down.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

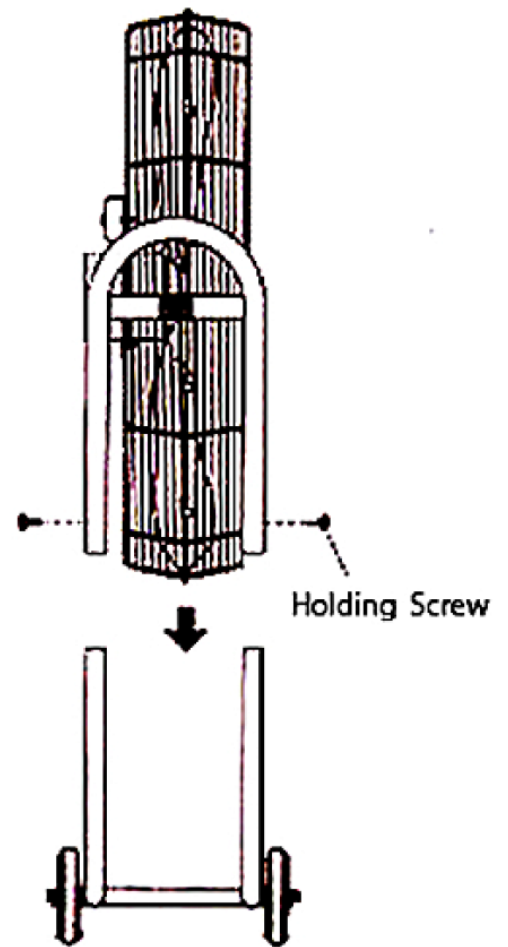
WARNING: Unplug the fan from the electrical supply source before cleaning.

- Use a soft, slightly moistened cloth and wipe off the surfaces of the fan. Do not use a chemical solution that can damage the paint and/or plastic of the fan.
- Be careful not to bend the blades of the fan when cleaning the fan.
- In order to remove dust from the grill, use a vacuum cleaner or remove the front grill by removing the securing screws on the edge of the grill. After cleaning, remount the grill. After doing this, fasten the screws on the edge of the grill.
