

- **Weight capacity: 264lbs (120kgs). Do not exceed the weight limit.**



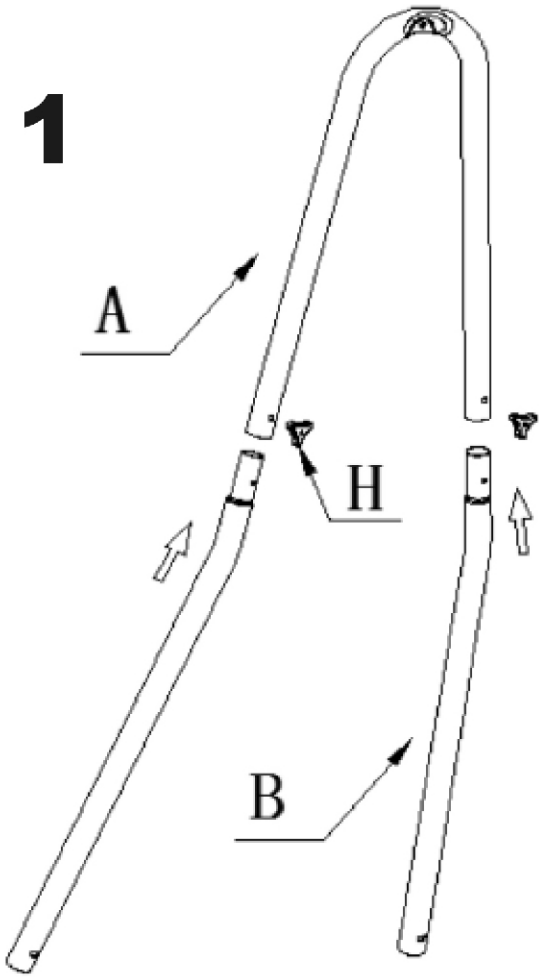
