OPERATION

TIP 1. By storing your cooling in a cool dry location you can start with a cool cooler. A warm cooler will melt ice in your cooler faster. If your cooler is warm you can pour a bag of ice to bring down the temperature of the cooler, then drain the first bag of ice before putting more ice, food and beverages.

TIP 2. If possible, freeze your food ahead of time before placing it into the cooler. This will ensure your food stays fresh and cool and that the ice melts slower.

TIP 3. Use plenty of ice. It is suggested to use dry or block ice and top it off with regular ice. Dry ice melts much slower then regular ice. You can make block ice at home by freezing water in tupperware ahead of time.

WARNING: Dry ice can can cause frostbite. Only handle dry ice with thick gloves and do not allow children to touch or handle dry ice.

TIP 4. Air pockets in your cooler will melt the ice faster. Use more ice, or a towel to cut down on the air pockests.
