Read carefully and understand all ASSEMBLY AND OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS before operating. Failure to follow the safety rules and other basic safety precautions may result in serious personal injury.

- The awning is primarily intended for protection against the sun. In case of wind, heavy rain or snow it should be closed immediately. Operating the awning in winter conditions can result in damage or malfunction of awning components.
- Before the assembly please check whether all of the delivered assembly components are of the right type and their amount is correct. Refer to the parts list to see what pieces have to be in the box.
- The awning is heavy. A minimum of two persons is required to hang the awning onto the wall brackets.
- DO NOT allow children to play in the work area during assembly and adjustments.
- DO NOT try to mount the awning alone. If the awning falls, it may cause serious injuries or get damaged.
- Please make sure that your hands are clean before the assembly, otherwise you may leave stains on the awning fabric and frame.
- Before starting the assembly, check the load capacity of the wall and if necessary take actions to ensure a proper installation of the wall brackets. If the wall is unstable, you may want to ask a specialist in your area.
- To Install the awning, technical knowledge is necessary. DO NOT mount the awning if you are unsure. Contact a professional installer if you are in doubt.
- Keep children and pets away from the working area during installation.
- This product and its fixing parts are only suitable for installation on a plain cement wall or stable, unrendered brickwork. If the wall shows crack, you have to consult a professional before installing the awning. If your building has an exterior shell (such as insulation, double brick or brick facing), installation should be carried out by a professional.
- In case of rain, retract the awning is less than $14^{\circ}$.
- DO NOT climb or hang anything off of the awning.
- When extended, carious forces including wind and rain can affect the awning. The substantial forces must be absorbed by the awning and transferred to the assembled structure via its mounting brackets. Under extreme loads, excessive attractive force can be exerted on the anchor bolts. Therefore, before starting assembly, check the load-bearing capacity of the mounting base and if necessary take corresponding measures to ensure stable installation of the brackets. If the mounting base is unstable, you have to consult a specialist in your vicinity.

## ASSEMBLY

## Installation Guide

The awning can be easily installed in about 30 minutes. For safe and easy locating of the awning, we recommend that 2 persons assist with lifting and positioning.

Suggested Tools:

1. Electric hammer
2. $\Phi 14$ shock drill
3. Level
4. Wrenches(one power socket near the position of installation is needed)

## Installation Step

## Step 1

- When selecting the proper height that you want to install the bracket and awning, the space and angle should be considered and marked on the wall.
- Install the two brackets along the line. A maximum distance of $1700 \mathrm{~mm} / 67 \mathrm{inch}$ from each bracket is suggested.
- The screws in the list are only suitable to be used on a concrete or solid wall.



## Step 2

Lift the awning into brackets and then fix it by M10 bolt.


## ASSEMBLY

## Step 3

The inclination of the awning is set by adjusting the Jack bolt and Locking nuts of the two arms. Loosen all the Jack bolt and Locking nuts, then adjust the arm:

- If you want the arm to go up, lift the arm and tighten all the Jack bolt and Locking nuts;
- If you want the arm to go down, lower the arm and tighten all the Jack bolt and Locking nuts;



## Step 4

Hang the Swing Hand hook up.


## ATTENTION

1. Do not hang clothes on any part of the awning.
2. You should often check the fixed bracket has become loose in the wind. If it loose, contact a professional to fix.
3. The awning should be fully retracted/closed in windy conditions.
